# How to tie a shoe

the \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_. Before you start to \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ the shoe, make sure that the laces are \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Adjective</sub>\_\_\_\_\_.

You can check for \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Adjective</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ laces by pulling up both ends \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Adverb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ to the shoe.

\_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ the laces. Cross the strings and lay them down on the \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_. Bring one string under the other and \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_.

Form a loop in one hand. \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ opposite string around the loop once and pull that string through the loop, creating \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Number</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ loops. \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ both loops.

\_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ out. Pull out the \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_ of the shoe position it comfortably on the \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_.

. If you want the shoes to stayed tied, you can create a \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Noun</sub>\_\_\_\_\_. Hold both loops and \_\_\_\_\_<sub>Verb</sub>\_\_\_\_\_. Bring one

loop through the "hole"; and \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb</sup>.
