It has an internal cavity known as the _____^{Adjective}_____ cavity that is continuous with the _____^{Adjective}_____ canal, the _____^{Body part}_____ below and the two openings in the upper portion leading to the _____^{Body part plural}_____ right and left. The lining of the cavity is called the _____^{Proper noun}_____.

During the menstrual cycle, which is regulated by the action of ovarian-secreted hormones, _____^{Liquid}_____ and _____^{Liquid}_____ the _____^{Proper noun (same as previous)}_____ lining thickens and the uterus sheds both the unfertilized egg and the thickened _____^{Proper noun (same as previous)}_____. The uterus varies in size depending on the woman's _____^{Type of clothing + the word size}_____ and whether she has had previous pregnancies. The average adult uterus is about _____^{Number}_____ inches long, _____^{Number}_____ inches wide, and _____^{Number}_____ inch thick. After menopause, the uterus shrinks to the pre-adolescent size.
