# Highlights of Hammurabi's Code

If a man has broken into a house he shall be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense before the breach and buried there.

If a man has committed \_\_\_\_\_ Crime and has been caught, that man shall be put to death.

If a man's wife be caught \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING with another, they shall be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense and cast into the water. If the wife's husband would save his wife, the king can save his servant.

If a man has knocked out the \_\_\_\_\_ Part of Body of a patrician, his \_\_\_\_\_ Same body part as just used shall be knocked out.

If a son has struck his father, his \_\_\_\_\_ Body part plural shall be cut off.
