Matthew 13:24-30

also. The \_\_\_\_\_ Proper Noun - Plural of the landowner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past  
\_\_\_\_\_ Tense \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun in your field? How then does it have tares?' And he said to them, 'An  
\_\_\_\_\_ Proper Noun has done this!' The \_\_\_\_\_ Proper Noun - Plural said to him, 'Do you want us, then, to go and  
\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form them up?' But he said, 'No; for while you are \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING up the tares,
