3. Brush chewing surface of each tooth. Hold _____^{Noun} flat then brush back and _____^{Verb - Base Form}.

4. Use tip of brush behind each front tooth both top and bottom.

5. Don't forget to brush the _____^{Part of Body} in a back to front _____^{Adverb} motion. This will remove _____^{FOOD} particles and freshen

your breath.
