# How to Brush Your Teeth

1. Place \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> at angle along \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> gumline. Gently \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Base Form</sup> back and forth.

Repeat for each \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>.

2. Brush \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> surface of each \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>, use a 45 degree angle in \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> half tooth strokes against the gumline.

3. Brush chewing surface of each tooth. Hold \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> flat then brush back and \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Base Form</sup>.

4. Use tip of brush behind each front tooth both top and bottom.

5. Don't forget to brush the \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Part of Body</sup> in a back to front \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adverb</sup> motion. This will remove \_\_\_\_\_<sup>FOOD</sup> particles and freshen

your breath.

REMEMBER TO \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Base Form</sup> AT LEAST 30 SECONDS ON EACH QUADRANT OF YOUR \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>.
