# Crossing a river

Crossing a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun can be very \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective, if you have the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb a raft. 1) Find a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective point to cross the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun at.

2) Make sure there aren't any \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural in the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.

3) If there aren't any \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural, dive into the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and bolt \_\_\_\_\_ Preposition or subordinating conjunction.

4) You \_\_\_\_\_ Modal have made it across the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun now. In fact, you could use these steps \_\_\_\_\_ Number times and still be fine!
