is kidnapped by pirates one day later. The pirates return Hamlet to Claudius, and Claudius tries one last attempt
to Hamlet: he arranges a sword duel between Laertes and Hamlet. The trick, however, is that the
tip of Laertes' sword is As a backup precaution, Claudius poisons the victory cup in
case Hamlet wins. During the fight, the drink is offered to Hamlet, he declines, and instead
Gertrude Noun - Plural it. Laertes, losing to Hamlet, illegally scratches him with the poisoned sword to
ensure Hamlet's death. Hamlet, unknowingly, then switches with Laertes, and cuts and
poisons him. The queen dies, screaming that she has been poisoned and Laertes, dying, admits of Claudius'
treachery. Weakening, Hamlet fatally
