with is a hard ball that is white with <u>Adjective</u> Noun that wrap around it. It is called a Noun . The object of baseball is to score the most runs in the end. There are 9 Adjective positions. These include pitcher, catcher, 1st base, 2nd base, shortstop, 3rd _____, left field, center field, and Adjective field. The game begins with the <u>Adjective</u> team batting. The <u>Noun</u> tries to hit the ball and quickly run to a base. The batter has the goal to run to as many bases as possible. When you are out you have to go back to your dugout. Getting out is either when a fielder <u>Adverb</u> throws the ball to a <u>Noun</u> and they tag the base that the runner is running to or if a fielder catches the ball in midair. If you do touch home base then one point is verb to your <u>Noun</u>. If there were other <u>Noun</u> on base and they run and make it to home <u>Noun</u> too they will score also. A home run is when the ball is <u>Adverb</u> hit very far that the batter is able to run to all three bases and home without getting out. If a home run is hit the crowd will usually Adverb cheer for the team, if it is the team they are rooting for. Whoever has the most points in the end will win. If there is a tie you go into "extra innings." Once a team has broken the tie at the end of the inning, they will happily win the game. After they win the team will go on the field and politely say "_____ game" and congratulate their ______, the proud Noun - Plural they congratulate their players when they come into the dugout.
