The chase started about \_\_\_\_\_ Number a.m. when officers in Calumet Park saw the driver of a van commit several traffic violations, a police source said. They learned the license plate \_\_\_\_\_ Preposition the van belonged to a different vehicle -- a \_\_\_\_\_ Common Noun -- and began pursuing it, sources said.

The chase ended with a \_\_\_\_\_ Action Verb in the 8700 block of South \_\_\_\_\_ Common Noun Avenue just off the Dan Ryan Expy., police said. Two Calumet Park police vehicles were on the scene, too. Illinois State Police vehicles were in the area of the crash preparing for a crime "saturation" mission, but they're not believed to have been involved in the chase, a state police spokeswoman said.

Police allegedly found marijuana in the van and arrested the driver, a Calumet Park woman who has a history of driving without a license as well as theft convictions. A passenger, a 33-year-old Harvey man, also was arrested, sources said.
