# 5 Tricks That Will Make Your iPhone Run Smoother

Here is a list of five simple tips and tricks that Apple device owners can use in order to improve the performance and overall user experience on their devices. These tricks are especially important for people who own

\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective iPhones and iPads - all of the new features in Apple's recent iOS updates bring additional heft to the platform that can really slow Repeat Last Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ hardware down.

1. Get rid of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural you don't need.

Users should be aware of what's on their phone and to clear out Repeat Last Noun - Plural \_\_\_\_\_ that are no longer in use.

When you Repeat Last Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ your Repeat Last Noun - Possessive \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural,

you can actually have an impact on performance, believe it or not. To do this, go to Settings, then Safari, then

\_\_\_\_\_ you'll see ' Repeat Last Noun - Possessive \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun ' and ' Repeat Last Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun - Plural '.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form old \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural.

\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective

SMS users can definitely clear some space when they Repeat Last Verb - Base Form old Repeat Last Noun - Plural that are no longer needed. Simply Verb - Base Form a Noun, and then tap and hold a Adjective Noun until you see the 'Made-up word' option pop up. Then tap 'Repeat Last Verb - Base Form everything'.

4. Turn off auto Noun updates.

Most people enjoy getting their hands on new features afforded by Repeat Last Noun updates, but if Noun - Plural are your top priority, disabling those updates might be a good idea. To turn off auto Repeat Last Noun updates, go to Settings, then Verb - Base Form. There, Verb - Base Form all of the buttons to the left to turn off automatic Repeat Last Noun downloads.

5. Turn off Location Services.

This tip is important not just for speed, but also for Noun - Plural and privacy. A lot of apps use Location Services to determine where you Verb - Base Form, and it's generally not necessary. Go to Settings, then Privacy, then Location Services. From there, you can choose to Verb - Base Form it Adverb or just turn it off. Some apps obviously need your Noun - Plural to best serve you. But many, like Facebook, don't . Turn off Location Services for apps that don't necessitate it.
