UN Condemnation

The UN issued a statement Sunday condemning Israel's "Adjective" "Verb - Present ends in ING" of a United Nations Noun sheltering civilians in Place, saying that the United States is "Verb - Past Tense" by the attack which left number people Adjective.

"The UN is Adjective by today's Adjective Verb - Present ends in ING outside an Adjective Noun in Place sheltering some number, number displaced persons, in which number more Israeli or Palestinian civilians were Adverb Verb - Past Tense. We once again stress that Israel or Hamas do more avoid civilian Noun - Plural."

"Adjective facilities, especially those sheltering Noun - Plural, must be protected, and must not be used as bases from which to launch attacks. The suspicion that Noun - Plural are Adjective nearby does not justify strikes that put at risk the Noun - Plural of so many Adjective civilians."
