# Figurative Languages & Examples

simile: comparison of \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ unlike things using "like" or "as"

Examples: Being in the school play for the first time felt like \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ to me.

Life feels like a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ sometimes.

metaphor: comparison of \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ unlike things without using "like" or "as"

personification: concept of giving human-like qualities to non-human things

oxymoron: figure of speech when two \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ words provide a meaning

hyperbole: use of exaggeration to emphasize an idea

alliteration: occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of closely connected words

Examples:
