## Figurative Languages & Examples

simile: comparison of unlike things using "like" or "as"
Examples: Being in the school play for the first time felt like <u>Noun</u> to me.
Life feels like a <u>Noun</u> sometimes.
metaphor: comparison of unlike things without using "like" or "as"
Examples: Actress <u>First Name of a Person</u> Collins is today's <u>First Name of a Person</u> Hepburn.
Little First Name of a Person was just such an angel whenever she slept!
personification: concept of giving human-like qualities to non-human things
Examples: Poor First Name of a Person had been Verb - Past Tense by the cruel Body Part - Plural of
death!

oxymoron: figure of speech when two \_\_\_\_\_\_ words provide a meaning

Examples: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ had been told many times that she looked almost exactly like model Kate

alliteration: occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of closely connected words
