# More Misplaced & Dangling Modifiers

In English, modifiers describe a word or make its meaning more specific. A misplaced modifier is a phrase or clause placed \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb \_\_\_\_\_ in a sentence so that it appears to modify or refer to an unintended word. A dangling modifier is a modifier that has nothing to modify. Here are examples:
