After serving Number years, Red is finally paroled. He struggles to adapt to life outside prison and fears he never will. Remembering his promise to Andy, he visits Buxton and finds a cache containing money and a letter asking him to come to Place. Red violates his parole and travels to Place Proper Noun, Place to cross the border to Place, admitting he finally feels Abstract concept.

On

a beach in Place he finds Andy, and the two friends are Adjective reunited.
