## **CAN SPAM Act**

Any opt-out mechanism you offer must be able to process opt-out requests for at least days after
you send your message. You must honor a recipient's opt-out request within business days. You
can't charge a fee, require the recipient to give you any personally information beyond
an email address, or make the recipient take any step other than sending a reply or visiting a
single page on an Internet website as a condition for honoring an opt-out Once people have told
you they don't want to receive more from you, you can't sell or transfer their email addresses
, even in the form of a list. The only exception is that you may transfer the addresses to a
company you've hired to help you comply with the Proper Noun Act.
