# Pink Floyd description

Pink Floyd were an \_\_\_\_\_ Nationality \_\_\_\_\_ Genre of Music band formed in London. They achieved international acclaim with their \_\_\_\_\_ Specific Type of Music and \_\_\_\_\_ Specific Type of Music music. Distinguished by their use of \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective lyrics, sonic \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING, extended \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural and elaborate live shows, they are one of the most commercially successful and musically \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective groups in the history of \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective music.

Pink Floyd was founded in \_\_\_\_\_ Year by students Syd Barrett, Nick Mason, Roger Waters, and Richard Wright. They gained popularity \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING in London's underground music scene during the late \_\_\_\_\_ Decade, and under Barrett's leadership released \_\_\_\_\_ Number charting singles and a successful debut album, The \_\_\_\_\_ Noun at the Gates of Dawn (1967). David Gilmour joined as a \_\_\_\_\_ Number member in December 1967; Barrett left the band in \_\_\_\_\_ Month 1968 due to deteriorating \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective health. Waters became the band's primary lyricist and, by the \_\_\_\_\_ Decade, their dominant songwriter, devising the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural behind their critically and commercially successful albums The \_\_\_\_\_ Color Side of the Moon (1973), Wish You Were Here (1975), \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural (1977), The \_\_\_\_\_ Noun (1979) and The Final Cut (1983).

Wright left Pink Floyd in 1979, followed by Waters in 1985, declaring it a "\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun". Gilmour and Mason continued as Pink Floyd; Wright rejoined them as a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective musician and, later, a band

member. The three produced \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Number</sup> more albums, A \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> Lapse of \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> (1987) and The Division \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> (1994), and toured until \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup>. After nearly two decades of acrimony, Pink Floyd reunited with Waters in \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup> for a performance at the global awareness event Live \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Number</sup>, but Gilmour and Waters have since stated they have no plans to reunite as a band again. Barrett died in \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup> and Wright in 2008. A new Pink Floyd studio album recorded without Waters partially originating from \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> recorded in 1993-1994, The Endless \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>, was released in \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Month</sup> 2014.

Pink Floyd was inducted into the \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Country</sup> Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1996, and the \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Country</sup> Music Hall of Fame in 2005. By 2013, the band had sold more than \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Number</sup> million records worldwide, including 74.5 million certified units in the United \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup>.
