\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING Step 3 is like the \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING of a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun which to all  
appearances is still \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense. All we need is a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, and the

willingness. Once \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense by willingness, the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun opens almost of itself, and

\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING through it, we shall see a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun beside which is an inscription. It reads: "
