Def Proper Noun Noun Vivian Campbell is pulling out of the rock band's tour after his cancer returned.

Campbell, 52, announced two years ago that he was getting chemotherapy for Hodgkin lymphoma, which affects the lymphatic system.

He later said he was Verb - Past Participle remission.

"I'm saddened by the fact that my Preposition or subordinating conjunction has returned," he said in a statement Saturday. "However, I'm beyond consolation that its Noun will prevent me from being able to do my job for a while."

Campbell joined Def Leppard in 1992. Before that, he was in a series of other bands, Verb - Present Tense Whitesnake and Shadow King.
