How To Use A Tampon For The First Time

How to Use

Relax. It's much easier to <u>Verb - Base Form</u> a tampon when you're relaxed. It usually takes a few tries before being able to comfortably Repeat Last Verb - Base Form a tampon, so don't worry. A tampon is actually made up of 2 ________ - the tampon itself that you insert into your body, and the Adjective Noun you use to insert it. • 1. Wash your <u>Part of Body</u> and then unwrap the tampon. The slim applicator tip should be rounded and Noun - Plural should hang out the bottom of the applicator. If you notice any flaws, do not use. While holding the applicator, gently pull on Repeat Last Noun - Plural to make sure they are firmly attached. 2. Get comfortable. Try <u>Verb - Present ends in ING</u> on the toilet with <u>Part of Body</u> apart or standing with one ______ on the toilet seat. 3. Insert the applicator: hold the applicator plunger using your <u>Part of Body</u> and middle finger. Place the applicator tip into your Part of Body at a 45? angle. Now, gently slide the Adjective , tapered applicator all the way into your <u>Part of Body</u> until your fingers touch your body.

Push the tampon inside: push the plunger all the way into the <u>Noun</u> with your <u>Adjective</u> finger. This will release the tampon. The plunger should now be inside the Repeat Last Noun Still holding the plunger, gently pull out the <u>Adjective</u> applicator. The tampon should now be comfortably inside you in its <u>Adjective</u> place with the Repeat Last Noun - Plural outside your body.

After you have the tampon, place the used applicator back into the <u>Adjective</u> <u>Noun</u> and throw away. DO NOT <u>Verb - Base Form</u> THE <u>Adjective</u> APPLICATOR.

5. Any discomfort? The tampon may not be far enough inside. If this happens, just <u>Verb - Base Form</u> the

tampon and try again with a <u>Adjective</u> one. You won't feel anything when the tampon is <u>Adverb</u> in place.
