# THE GENERAL PLAN

The \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective plan is a community's blueprint for \_\_\_\_\_ Noun development. It \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - 3rd Person Singular Present a community's \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural and policies. It also is the foundation for land use decisions made by the planning \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, city council, or board of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural.

A general \_\_\_\_\_ Noun consists of at least two \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural. It must \_\_\_\_\_ Verb a written \_\_\_\_\_ Noun describing the community's goals, \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural, and policies for \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. It must also contain a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun (or \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural) and diagrams \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present Tense the generalized \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of land uses, the road \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective hazard areas, the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective space system, and other policy \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural that can be illustrated (\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective Code Section 65302). The maps and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural must work together with the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective portions of the plan to establish a clear \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of the community's \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.

The \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective plan must \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form at least \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective components (called mandatory \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural) addressing a set of \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective planning issues (Government Code Section 65302).

Each city and county \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - 3rd Person Singular Present the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective importance of these issues to their local \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural and decides how they are to be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Participle in the general plan. They may also \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb adopt additional \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural, called \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural, covering subjects

of local interest. Some examples of optional elements include: air \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>, recreation, community

Although general plans are not required to \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Base Form</sup> a standard \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>, many  
\_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Base Form</sup> similar features. Some of the things to look for in the written portion of a general plan  
are \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> (abstract and general expressions of community \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup>), \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun -</sup>  
\_\_\_\_\_<sup>Plural</sup> (\_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> intermediate \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> in attaining a \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup>), \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup>  
(specific \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> that guide \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb - Present ends in ING</sup>), and implementation  
\_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> (\_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup> of how the \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup>, \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun - Plural</sup>, and
