were Verb - Past Participle at what the shepherds said to them. 19 But Mary treasured up all these things and  
pondered them in her Noun. 20 The shepherds returned, Verb - Present Tense and Verb -  
Present Tense Proper Noun for all the things they had Verb - Past Participle and Verb - Past  
Participle, which were just as they had been told.
