The series began in 1977 with the release of _________ film Star ________ verb-Past Participle______ (subtitled Episode IV: A New Hope in 1981[2][3][4]) by 20th Century Fox, which became a ________ pop culture phenomenon. It was followed by the similarly successful sequels The Empire Strikes Back (1980) and Return of the Jedi (1983); these three films constitute the ________ Star Wars trilogy. A prequel trilogy was later released between 1999 and 2005, which received a more mixed reaction _______ Prepasition or subordinating conjunction _______ critics and fans in comparison to the original trilogy. All six films were nominated for or won ________ Proper _______ Noun ______ Awards, and _______ commercial successes, with a combined box office revenue of \$4. 38 billion.[5] making Star Wars the fourth highest-grossing film series.[6]

The series has spawned an extensive media franchise--the Star Wars expanded universe--including books, television series, computer and video games, and comic books, <u>Adjective</u> in significant development of the series's fictional universe. Star Wars also holds a Guinness World Records title for the "Most successful film merchandising franchise." <u>Preposition or subordinatine conjunction</u> 2012, the total value of the Star Wars franchise was estimated at USD \$30.7 billion, including box-office receipts as well as profits from their video games and DVD sales.[7]

In 2012, The Walt Disney Company acquired Lucasfilm for \$4.06 billion and announced three new Star Wars films; _______ first film of that trilogy, Star Wars: The Force Awakens, was released in 2015.[8] 20th Century Fox retains the physical _______ rights to the first two Star Wars trilogies, owning permanent rights for the original 1977 film and holding the _______ to ______ roper Noun ______ I-III, V and VI until May 2020.[9][10] Walt Disney Studios owns digital distribution ________ to all the Star ________ to all the Star __________ films, excluding A New Hope.[10][11]
