Noun - Plural Behavior Policy
The MOMS Club(r) activities are meant to be <u>Adjective</u> and <u>Adjective</u> events for both
Noun - Plural and Noun - Plural . The MOMS Club(r) respects parenting differences, but expects that
all children <u>Adjective</u> <u>Adverb</u> at MOMS Club(r) activities. <u>Adjective</u> behaviors will not
be <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> . These <u>Adjective</u> behaviors include, but are not limited to:

In the event that these occur during MOMS Club(r) activities, then the
child's mother should remove her child from the area.
When <u>Verb - Present ends in ING</u> your child, please remove the child from the <u>Adjective</u> area and do so
in a tone of so as not to further or Adjective others in
the group. In situations that involve <u>Adjective</u> behavior(s), the mother should <u>Verb - Base Form</u> the
child from the area for an <u>Adjective</u> period of time. The child's <u>Noun</u> will be expected to keep
an especially watch over the child if attempt to Verb - Base Form Verb - Base Form
on another child is made. If the child attempts the <u>Noun</u> a second time at the same activity, the mother
must <u>Verb - Base Form</u> the child from the MOMS Club(r) activity for that day.

Mother's <u>Noun</u> Policy

The MOMS Club(r) is here to support <u>Noun - Plural</u> and their <u>Noun - Plural</u>. We support all mothers and recognize that there are many different parenting styles and personalities in our club. To ensure the comfort of moms from all <u>Proper Noun</u> and <u>Proper Noun</u> backgrounds, we ask that all members follow these <u>Noun</u> Guidelines.

them and take the other <u>Noun</u> to his/her <u>Noun</u> . Address the <u>Verb - Base Form</u> with the
other mother at that time. You may contact the Proper Noun - Plural Board to discuss the
Verb - Base Form if you feel it is necessary.
5. <u>Proper Noun - Plural</u> shall not misuse the MOMS $Club(r)$ <u>Noun</u> or its contents, as set forth in the
Proper Noun - Plural
