The Story of SRM

The story of SRM dates back to 2003, when four University of Washington <u>Noun - Plural</u> decided to leave the University and go into private practice. Dr. Michael Soules had been the <u>Noun</u> of the University's Reproductive Endocrinology division for over 20 years, and had recruited Dr. Klein in 1993 and Drs. Thyer and Lin in 2001. Although they were <u>Adjective</u> to leave their teaching and their research, it had become apparent that their <u>Noun</u> for their patients could be best accomplished in a new, <u>Adjective</u> setting. Led by Dr. Soules, the four doctors began making <u>Noun - Plural</u>.

The first step was to obtain the several million dollars required to <u>Noun</u> a brand new facility and hire the necessary staff. It was then when they <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> of Integramed, a fertility management company that was willing to take a risk on these four <u>Noun - Plural</u>. They searched around Seattle to find a building that could accommodate the requirements of an IVF lab and clinic, <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> with architects and designers, and started demolition on a <u>Adjective</u> little office space on Westlake in July, 2004. A few short weeks later, on September 24, Seattle Reproductive Medicine opened its <u>Noun - Plural</u> to its first new patient.

Over the following years, the practice grew, with addition of Drs. Criniti, <u>Proper Noun</u> and Davis and the opening of clinics in Bellevue and Tacoma. In 2011, a <u>Noun</u> with Northwest Center for Reproductive Sciences in Kirkland brought a fourth clinic site as Drs. Kennedy and Letterie <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> the practice

Drs. Barker and Cho <u>Verb-Past Tense</u> out the team, and SRM set its sights on Eastern Washington. SRM Spokane opened its doors in 2014 staffed by Drs. Houmard and Fisher. Today, SRM has twelve reproductive <u>Noun-Plural</u>, three urologists, five locations, and a <u>Adjective</u> and dedicated staff bringing state of the art reproductive health care to thousands of <u>Noun-Plural</u> each year.
