How to wash a dog.

To wash a dog, you need a <u>Animal</u>, dog soap(dog shampoo and dog conditioner), some type of <u>Noun</u> source, and a towel. First, <u>Verb - Base Form</u> your dog with water. The water can not be to hot or to cold. Next, lather your dog in soap. Make sure you do not get the soap close to their <u>Part of Body</u> or <u>Preposition</u> their ears. Then, rinse their <u>Noun</u> with water in a downward motion so the gets out of their fur. Do not put water in the <u>Animal</u> ear because the water will bother the dogs <u>Part of</u> <u>Body</u>. <u>Verb - Present ends in ING</u> TIME. Let your dog shake most of the dripping water off of them. Then you are ready to dry them with a <u>Noun</u>. <u>Adverb</u> dry the inside of the ear just in case if any <u>Noun</u> got inside of the ear.
