On July 2, 1776, the <u>Proper Noun</u> Congress formally voted for <u>Noun</u>, and issued its Declaration on July 4. However, it was not until August 2, 1776 that the Declaration of <u>Noun</u> was taken into place and first signed by <u>Proper Noun</u>. Meanwhile, the <u>Proper Noun</u> were mustering <u>Noun - Plural</u> to suppress the <u>Noun</u>. Sir William Howe outmaneuvered and defeated Washington, capturing New York City and New Jersey. Washington was able to <u>Verb</u> a <u>Proper Noun</u> detachment at Trenton and drive the British out of most of New Jersey. In 1777 Howe's army launched a <u>Noun</u> against the national capital at Philadelphia, failing to aid <u>Proper Noun</u> separate invasion force from Canada. Burgoyne's army was <u>Verb Past Participle</u>, and surrendered after the Battles of Saratoga in October 1777.
