How to put up a tent

When pitching a tent, the first thing to do is to <u>Verb - Base Form</u> the site where you want to pitch your tent. Next, you want to get out your <u>Adjective</u> poles, and <u>Verb - Base Form</u> your tent. After this, <u>Verb - Base Form</u> the Repeat Last Adjective poles through the <u>Adjective</u> holes in the top of the tent. Next, you wanna erect the tent, just like you would a <u>Noun</u> or a <u>Noun</u>. By this point, you re almost done. The last step is to <u>Verb - Base Form</u> a couple of <u>Noun - Plural</u> into the ground to insure that your tent won't be blown away by the <u>Adjective - Ends in EST</u> <u>Noun</u> storm. Now your tent has been pitched, and you did it with your own two <u>body part-plural</u>...you should be proud.
