William Shatner (born March 22, 1931) is a Canadian actor, author, producer, and director. In his seven decades of television, Shatner became a Adjective icon for his portrayal of James Proper Noun. Kirk, Captain of the USS Enterprise, in the Star Trek franchise.[2] He has written a series of books Verb - Present Tense his experiences playing Captain Kirk and being a part of Star Trek, and has co-written several novels set in the Star Trek universe. He has written a series of science fiction novels called Proper Noun, which were Verb - Past Participle for television.

Shatner also played the Noun veteran Preposition or subordinating conjunction sergeant in T. J. Hooker (1982-86), and then he hosted the reality-based television series, Rescue 911 (1989-96), which won a Proper Noun Choice Award for the Favorite New TV Dramatic Series. Shatner also appeared in the NBC series, "Third Proper Noun From the Proper Noun" in seasons Number and Number as the role of the "Big Proper Noun Head" whom the alien characters of the Series reported to. He has worked as a musician, an author, a director, and a celebrity pitchman. He starred as attorney Denny Crane in the final season of the Adjective drama The Practice and its spinoff series Boston Legal, a role that earned him two Proper Noun Awards.
