Annually, in Utah, we make significant and and investments across all sections of the
education Despite these investments, disparities based on where our children verb Base
Form, what language they verb Base Form first, how much Noun Plural their parents make, and
the color of their skin persist and - in many locations - grow.
In the Kearns High School pattern (total K-12 enrollment: 6,282), disparities are especially
apparent. Established in 2011, the Promise Kearns, led by United Way of Salt Lake (UWSL), has
been to address these disparities. UWSL, the lead for the Partnerships
for Student Success, and Promise Kearns partners recognize that the moment could not be more
to invest in the partnerships and systems that will create better for our
children, families, and communities. Promise Kearns draws on the Noun Plural and Noun Plural of
Granite School District, multiple nonprofits, private businesses, government agencies, philanthropies, healthcare
organizations, and Salt Lake County. This proposal builds on a Noun that exists in four community
