The Government Shutdown Comes to an End

President Trump has _____ Verb Past Tense a _____ Adjective spending bill passed by Congress on Monday, ending the partial shutdown of the federal government after three days.

The White House has said _____ Adjective government operations will resume by Tuesday morning.

The bill passed the Senate on Monday afternoon with a 81 - 18 vote, but the real hurdle was the procedural vote earlier in the day requiring at least _____ Number votes.
