A number of new <u>Noun Plural</u> have <u>Verb Past Tense</u> up in our Salesforce account.
This is not OK, because each <u>Noun</u> costs \$1600/yr. <u>First Name of a Person</u> and <u>First Name of a</u>
Person are <u>Verb Present ends in ING</u> this today, but going forward, be aware of our policy on
software like Salesforce.
There are two types of Salesforce <u>Noun Plural</u> :
1) <u>Adjective</u> <u>Adjective</u> users (UNIQUE SEATS). These include <u>Noun Plural</u> ,
, etc. who write data and that data must be Verb Past Tense with them in the audit log, so
they need unique <u>Noun Plural</u> .
2) users (SHARED SEATS). These are users that or or verb Base
Form Salesforce data, possibly even create <u>Noun Plural</u> as well, but they don't <u>Verb Base Form</u>
data. These must be <u>Verb Past Tense</u> to the maximum possible, i.e. through <u>Verb Present ends in ING</u>
accounts. <u>Food</u> should be turned off so these <u>Noun Plural</u> are <u>Adverb</u> shareable.
