The Gerudo witches, Koume and Kotake, together known as \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun*, are said to also \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* the tribe from afar.

Link first \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Present ends in S* the Gerudo tribe during his younger years, when the Gerudo's tight \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun* at the bridge took away any chance of proceeding into their domain. Seven years later however, the \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* bridge becomes an obstacle easily passed with the \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun* (Or optionally, with \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun*). Before he could set him free, a Gerudo Thief appears and challenges Link to a battle.
