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The storyline in the sequels really follows Jake and Neytiri, and their Animal - Plural. It's more of a family saga about the struggle with Noun Plural.

We made the decision for the sequels not to do necessarily what other science fiction movies do, which is if they want Noun Plural they go to the Repeat Last Noun Plural planet; and if they want Noun Plural, they go to the Repeat Last Noun Plural planet.

We looked at all the Noun Plural the Earth shows us, and we realized we could travel our whole lives and not Verb Base Form all the Adjective Repeat Last Noun Plural Earth has. So I made the decision to set the sequels all on Pandora. Our stories introduce us to different environments, and also Adjective Animal - Plural.

We're making standalone movies that will stand alone. Rather than rushing into doing the sequels, we have to Verb Base Form our Noun Plural, and that's the Adjective Ends in EST. Knowing that we wanted to tell multiple stories, we didn't just want to solve one script. We wanted to solve the scripts for all of the movies we wanted to make before we ventured out into making them. That's what took us the time.
