# Apply Updates

For immediate release:

A critical vulnerability has been discovered in all computers, phones, and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural made by \_\_\_\_\_ Company since \_\_\_\_\_ Year.

This vulnerability allows a hacker to \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb gain access to a network and begin stealing \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural.
