# Tips for Traveling Abroad

If you are traveling abroad here are the top 5 tips you need to make your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ easier:

1. Make sure you have a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ valid passport and \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun \_\_\_\_\_ if required. Also, before you \_\_\_\_\_ Verb \_\_\_\_\_ fill in the emergency information page of your passport!

2. Read the Consular Information \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun \_\_\_\_\_ (and Public Announcements or Travel Warnings, if applicable) for the countries you plan to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb \_\_\_\_\_.

3. Familiarize yourself with \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ laws and customs of the countries to which you are traveling. Remember, the U.S. \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ does not follow you! While in a foreign country, you are subject to its \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun \_\_\_\_\_.

4. Make \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ copies of your passport identification page. This will facilitate replacement if your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ Verb (past tense) \_\_\_\_\_ or stolen. Leave one copy at home with friends or relatives. Carry the other with you in a separate place from your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_.

5. Leave a copy of your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ with family or friends at home so that you can be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb (past tense) \_\_\_\_\_ in case of an emergency.
