 on a <u>Noun</u> is <u>Adjective</u> and takes a lot of practice. It is <u>Adjective</u> for <u>Noun</u> to get

 frustrated at first, but once you feel comfortable doing it, you will feel <u>Adjective</u> and <u>Adjective</u>.

 There are three simple steps to guide you in doing this <u>Noun</u>:
