Underwear

Underwear, also called underpants or <u>Plural noun</u> are clothes worn next to the skin, usually under other clothes.

The loincloth is the simplest form of underwear; it was probably the first undergarment worn by

<u>Adjective</u> Plural noun. A loincloth may take three major forms. The first, and simplest, is simply a long strip of <u>Noun</u> which is passed between the legs and then around the <u>Noun</u>.

In the 1950s, underwear manufacturers began marketing printed and colored <u>Plural noun</u>. What had once been a simple, <u>Adjective</u> piece of clothing not to be shown in public suddenly became a fashion statement . The manufacturers also experimented with rayon and newer fabrics like <u>Noun</u> and <u>Noun</u>. By 1960, men's underwear was regularly printed in <u>Adjective</u> patterns or with images ranging from <u>Plural noun</u> to cartoon <u>Plural noun</u>.

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
