## Graduation

Graduation is the action of receiving or conferring an academic degree or the associated ceremony. The date of event is often called <u>Proper noun</u> day. The event itself is also called commencement, convocation or <u>Event</u>. In the United States and <u>Location</u> it is also used to refer to the advancement from a primary or secondary school level. Many colleges have different traditions associated with the graduation ceremony, the best-known probably being throwing <u>Plural noun</u> in the air.

A graduation or commencement speech is a <u>Adjective</u> speech given by a <u>Noun</u> or by alumnus of a university to a graduating class and their guests. Common themes of the graduation speech include wishing the graduates well in the real world, cautioning that the world of academe is a special place where they were taught to <u>Verb</u>. Most recently, especially in <u>Adjective</u> institutions, the trend has been to find a celebrity or a <u>Noun</u> to <u>Verb</u> the <u>Noun</u>.
