There are three types of pests: Shell Creepers, Side Steppers, and Fighter Flies.

- Shell Creepers: (possible inspiration for the later Koopa Troopas) look like \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun \_\_\_\_\_. They move slowly, though it will move the same speed as Mario when it is hit \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ times and not kicked and it only takes one hit to flip them over. Later replaced with Spinys in the Super Mario Advance series.
