Connery's breakthrough came in the role of secret agent _____^{Last name}. He played the character in seven

_____^{Plural noun} Are Forever, and Never Say _____^{Noun} Again. All _____^{Number} films were
commercially successful.

James Bond's creator, Ian Fleming, doubted the casting, saying, 'He's not what I _____^{Past tense verb} of James
Bond looks' and 'I'm looking for _____^{Adjective} Bond and not an overgrown _____^{Noun}, adding that
Connery was unrefined. However, Fleming's girlfriend told him Connery had the requisite sexual _____^{Noun}.
Fleming changed his mind after the successful Dr. No premiere; he was so _____^{Past tense verb} he created a
half-Scottish, _____^{Adjective} heritage for the literary James Bond in the later _____^{Plural noun}.
