Windmills

Windmills have existed for at least 1,300 years. The first windmills had <u>Adjective</u> shafts with <u>Noun</u> shaped blades and appeared in Persia around the 7th century, though they were quite different from the European versions. Made of six to twelve sails covered in <u>Adjective</u> <u>Plural noun</u> or cloth, they were used to <u>Verb</u> <u>Plural noun</u> or draw up water. A similar type of vertical shaft windmill with rectangle blades, used for irrigation, can also be found in 13th century <u>Location</u>. The horizontal-shaft windmill was developed and built in Europe in the twelfth century. People still use <u>Plural noun</u> for the blade shapes.
