## **Car Insurance**

In the United States, liability insurance covers claims against the policy holder and generally, any other operator of the insureds <u>Noun</u> provided they do not <u>Verb</u> at the same <u>Noun</u> as the policy holder and are not specifically excluded on the policy. In the case of those <u>Verb ending in lag</u> at the same address, they must specifically be covered on the policy. Thus it is necessary for example, when a family <u>Noun</u> comes of driving age they must be added on to the policy. Liability insurance sometimes does not <u>Verb</u> the policy holder if they operate any <u>Plurat noun</u> other than their own. When you <u>Verb</u> a vehicle owned by another <u>Noun</u> you are covered under that partys policy. Non-owners policies may be offered that would cover an insured on any <u>Noun</u> they <u>Verb</u>. This coverage is available only to those who do not <u>Verb</u> <u>Conjunction</u> Verb <u>Plurat noun</u> and is sometimes required by the government for <u>Plurat noun</u> who have previously been found at fault in an accident.
